HOW TO APPLY

Acceptance into the full-time Accelerated Honors JD Program (AHP) is competitive and requires completion of the McGeorge School of Law JD admissions application submitted through LSAC, as well as an interview.

ACCELERATED HONORS PROGRAM

PROGRAM FEATURES

- 10-week summer honors externship
- Heavier load of 17 units each semester after the first year
- Requires students maintain 3.0 GPA
